

Unit 4 • Session 1 GOD CALLED MOSES Exodus 1-4

WHY DOES SIN SEPARATE US FROM GOD? BECAUSE GOD IS HOLY, SIN HAS BROKEN OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD.

Years went by, and the family of Israel grew quickly. The land of Egypt was filled with God's people! This made the new king of Egypt nervous. "Let's make sure they know we are in charge so they don't join our enemies." So, the Egyptians appointed taskmasters over the family of Israel, made them slaves, and forced them to work very hard. Then Pharaoh commanded all their sons to be put to death.

A woman named Jochebed hid her baby boy for three months. When she could hide him no longer, she placed him in a basket in the Nile River. Pharaoh's daughter found the baby, so she decided to raise him as her son. She named the baby Moses.

"Here I am," Moses answered.


God told Moses that He had heard His people, the Israelites, crying out because of their suffering. God said, "I am sending you to Pharaoh to lead My people out of Egypt."
